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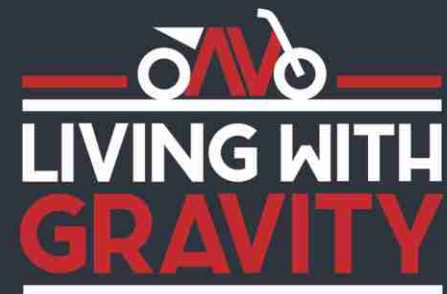

Which does mean Royal Enfield store will offer apparel, motorcycle and accessories.

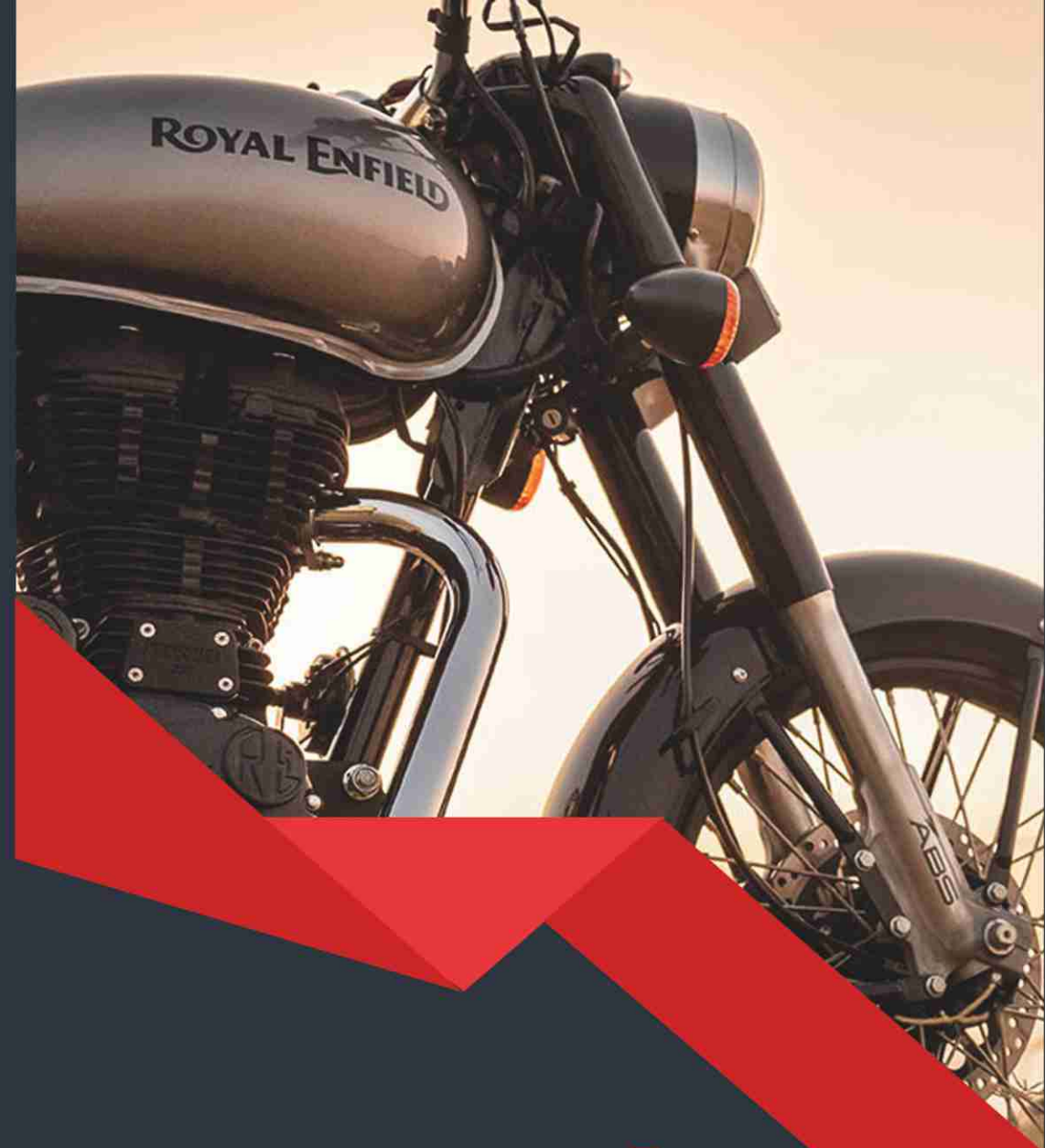
As far as the motorcycles are concerned, Royal Enfield enters Japan with
